GEC is primarily an online program, so access to the world wide web is essential.

SECTION 1: GEC programs are based on three basic Content Types.

1. Phonics and Early Reading

3. Academic English




SECTION 2: All GEC programs give balanced attention to English Skills.

INSTALLATION

GEC has apps for mobile devices (phone and tablet), but serious study is best performed on a pc, notebook computer or a tablet. Even on a tablet or phone, students can still study without the app, because the platform is primarily web based.

Even so, the mobile app on a smartphone can be useful, because the platform will send auto-notifications, helping students to stay on track in their studies.

SECTION 7: Make sure the device can receive notifications




Google Play

1. Go to the app store (Apple Store – or - Google Play Store) using your device.

4. Go to your GENERAL SETTINGS by clicking your name at the top right of the page. Make sure that email and mobile notifications are both enabled in your account.




Global CEFR Language Level



AReA is GEC's AI Powered Advanced Research Assistant

Has thousands of lessons from Kindergarten up through University Level courses. AReA allows you to learn by talking and asking question. The AI Learning Coach can answer in voice audio or in text output, and it works in multiple languages.

The interface on the monitor includes the following labeled components:

- Course Selector:** Points to the 'Select Grade' dropdown menu.
- Subject Selector:** Points to the 'Select Subject' dropdown menu.
