Asking about work: What is your job? What do you do? What kind of sales are you in? Asking about preference How do you like it? **Saying where you are from:** I'm from New York. I live in New York. I live near Times Square.

Talking about your job: I'm in sales. I sell computer software to other companies.

Giving your opinion of your job: It's very exciting.

Asking about companies: Who do you work for? What company do you work for? Who's your employer?

Saying where you work: I work for Ford I work at Apple.

Asking about hobbies: What are your hobbies? What things do you like to do for fun? What hobbies do you do in your spare time?

Talking about your hobbies:

I really love to go camping next to the ocean. I have just started learning how to rollerskate. My hobbies are cooking and spending time with my friends.
